What: Up to \$2,500 scholarship

Who: GRADUATE student conducting research in the subject area of water resources in Alaska.Student must be enrolled at least part time (6 credits minimum) in a graduate study program at any accredited Alaskan university or college. Multiple awardees may be selected.

Please submit the following scholarship documents for evaluation:

- Cover Letter
- Two letters of reference, including telephone numbers and email addresses
- Academic transcripts (do not need to be official)
- Proposal (not to exceed five pages)
 - o Introduction and research thesis statement
 - Objectives
 - Description of proposed methodology including:
 - Data collection and analysis
 - Details of any specialized techniques or instrumentation
 - o Schedule for completion
 - Statement of how scholarship funds will contribute to the research

To be given full consideration for the 2022 award, all documents must be received by April 1, 2022.
